### What do we collect?

We collect the following items for re-use; adults & children's clothes, soft toys, paired shoes, hats, belts, handbags - please note we cannot accept dirty or wet clothing, duvets, pillows, cushions or bedding.

### Which areas do you cover?

We cover all of Ireland.

### How much does it cost to do a collection?

Absolutely nothing. We provide the promotional posters and an information leaflet to be handed out to each member to encourage maximum participation.

### Who can run a Bag2TheFuture Collection?

Any club or organisation that needs funding. Eg. Sports clubs, playgroups, charities, church groups, community groups etc.

### What do we get paid?

We pay you 50p per kilo and weigh on site!

### When do we get paid?

Within 2-4 weeks



### Why should an organisation participate?

If you have unwanted good quality clothing, the best way to dispose of it is to donate or sell it for reuse

### What is the difference between Re-use, Recycle and Reduce?

The majority of our clothing is for Re-use, ie. someone will buy the clothing to wear. Recycle is where the clothing would be shredded to the raw material and made into new products such as mattress fillings, and Reduce is where less material and energy are used to make the product.

### When do we do a collection?

Most organisations benefit from a summer and winter collection

### What if it rains?

In the event of inclement weather, please protect your Bag2TheFuture investment by covering with a plastic sheet or storing the bags undercover. Remember wet clothes cannot be re-used.

### Where do the clothes go?

Mostly they are shipped to Africa, Asia and Eastern Europe, where a wholesaler then sorts them and sells them to market traders and boutiques at affordable prices.
